**Bell Mountain Gold Mine:** The Bell Mountain Property is located in Churchill County, Nevada, approximately 39 miles (63 km) southeast of Fallon. The claims are owned 100% by Globex Nevada, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company.

**The Vulcan Property:** The Vulcan Property, also known as Gold Dike, is located in Ferry County, Washington, two miles (3 km) from the Canada-United States border and four miles (6 km) southwest of Grand Forks, British Columbia. The property consists of 8 patented claims, 34 unpatented claims, and 11 optioned unpatented claims. Globex Nevada, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company holds a 100% interest in the property.

**The Hunters Point Property:** The Hunters Point Property consists of 13 cells totaling 763 hectares in the northeast corner of Atwater Township, Temiscamingue County, Quebec.

**Suffield Mine:** The property is located four miles (6 km) southwest of Sherbrooke, Quebec, Canada and consists of 9 mining claims, covering 617 hectares. The property is owned 100% by the company.

**Wemindji Project:** The company has a 100% interest in 616 cells covering 35,657 hectares (approximately 88,108 acres) in the Wemindji area of northwestern Quebec, east of James Bay.

**Gayhurst Property:** The Property consists of 10 claims totaling 595 hectares, situated in Dorset Township, Frontenac County, Quebec. The property is owned 100% by the company. The claim area is approximately 75 miles south of Quebec City and 135 miles east of Montreal.

**Grand Calumet:** The Property consists of 8 claims totaling 354.6 hectares located on lots 28 to 31 Range 7 and lots 30 to 33 Range 6, in Grand Calumet Township, Quebec, approximately 35km northwest of Hull on the Ottawa River and 2km north east of the village of Riviere-Berry. The property is 100% owned by Globex Mining Enterprises Inc.

**Fish Lake Gold Project:** The Property consists of four cell fractions and one claim totaling 32 hectares located in Tiblemont Township, Quebec. The claims are owned 100% by Globex Mining Enterprises Inc.

**Poirier Mine Property:** The Poirier Mine Property consists of 10 claims covering 316.4 hectares straddling the Joutel and Poirier township line in northwest Quebec, 7 km to the west of the site of the former town of Joutel and covers the area of the former Poirier Mining Concession #516 and a prospective area north of the mine.

**The Lyndhurst Property:** The Lyndhurst Property is located approximately 22 miles (35 km) due north of Rouyn-Noranda, Quebec. There are 88 claims plus one mining concession totaling 1,994 hectares. The company has a 100% ownership interest in the Lyndhurst property.

**Duvay Project:** The Duvay Project consists of 4 claims situated in Duvernoy Township,

Quebec, covering lots 10 to 12 inclusive, range 8 and lot 13, range 9. The claims are located approximately 17 km northeast of Amos, Quebec and are accessible by an all weather gravel road which joins directly to St. Maurice-de-Dalquier, 5 km to the south.

### Joint Venture Agreements

The company, in 2004, entered into a joint venture agreement with Queenston Mining Inc. agreeing to pool the company's Cadillac Wood Gold Mine claims and Queenston's adjacent claims, the Pandora gold property. With Globex as operator, the venturers would participate jointly in exploration, development, and mining of mineral resources within the expanded property package.

**Technological** – What impact do the technological aspects, innovations, incentives and barriers have on the organization?

**Environmental** – What environmental and ecological facets, both locally and farther afield, are likely to predetermine the business?

**Legal** – What laws and legislation will exert influence on the style the business is carried out?

## **IFE, EFE, IE Matrices**

The Internal Factor Evaluation matrix (IFE matrix) is a strategic management tool helping audit or evaluate major weaknesses and strengths in a business's functional areas. In addition, IFE matrix serves as a basis for identifying and assessing relationships amongst those areas. The IFE matrix is utilised in strategy formulation.

integrated into one suggestive model.
