This report analyzes the US and the European markets for Cosmetic Procedures and Products in US\$ Million.

Annual estimates and forecasts are provided for the period 2009 through 2017.

Also, a six-year historic analysis is provided for these markets.

The US market in the report is analyzed in terms of both Cosmetic Surgery Products and Cosmetic Procedures.

The major product segments analyzed under the Cosmetic Surgery Products Category include - Equipment (Lasers, Microdermabrators, and Other Equipment), Injectables (Botulinum Toxin Type A, Dermal Fillers, and Other Injectables), Implants (Breast Implants, and Other Implants), and others.

Major segments covered under the Cosmetic Surgery Procedures Category include - Surgical Procedures (Breast Augmentation, Abdominoplasty, Blenpharoplasty, Facelift, Liposuction, Rhinoplasty, and Others) and Non-Surgical Procedures (Botox, Dermal Fillers, Laser Hair Removal, Laser Skin Resurfacing, Chemical Peel, Microdermabrasion, and Others).
