

Azerbaijan Oil and Gas Report Q1 2016

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Abstracts

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BMI View: Lower oil prices are a bearish indicator for the Azeri oil sector, as reduced revenues undercut companies' ability to invest. Azerbaijan faces rapid depletion of its flagship ACG fields and this, alongside a lack of new production coming onstream, will drive output into secular decline from 2020. In contrast, the outlook on the Azeri gas sector is broadly bullish, driven by the second phase expansion at Shah Deniz. A substantial untapped resource base in the Caspian Sea offers upside risk to our forecast, although developments will ultimately hinge on the emergence a more supportive pricing environment.

Latest Updates and Key Forecasts:

The country boasts substantial, prospective and underexplored acreage, in particular offshore in the South Caspian basin. SOCAR has also announced plans to restart onshore exploration, targeting ultra-deep oil deposits.



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
