BMI View: It is our belief that Libya finds itself in a troublesome predicament with strong rivalry existing between Islamist leaning factions and state security forces at both the political and military level. BMI views the Libyan crisis as a threat to wider regional stability where neighbouring countries concerned about security on their own borders are becoming increasingly involved. We think that the international community, with the United Nations at the forefront, needs to pressure the political actors to the negotiating table.

Our view is that with the rival establishment of government and parliament in Tripoli by the General National Congress up against the internationally recognised government and parliament to the east of the country, the country is becoming more and more divided. Given that we expect the fighting between Islamist leaning militia's and government backed armed forces led by General Khalif Haftar to be a long drawn out process, we think there is a need for greater pressure by the international community to call for negotiations and an immediate ceasefire. We think that if there are no greater calls for national dialogue, the fluidity of movement on the ground risks dragging in other neighbouring regional actors.
