Abstracts

1. CCM elaborates on the current situation of the bio-based chemical fiber industry and its raw materials in China.

China intends to develop eco-friendly plasticizers in joint efforts by the government and enterprises. This is because conventional plasticizers still maintain a dominant position in China.

In recent years, the high-valued utilization industry of marine living resources, as a field with high effectiveness and innovativeness in international sci-tech innovation, has played an important part in the sustainable development of marine living resources in the world. China also devotes to its development and makes some progress.

8. A new production process developed will effectively lower the production costs of succinic acid, and push forward the development of bioplastics.
9. Since Mar. 2014, the market price of corn in China has been fluctuating and rising

slowly, due to the governmental policy and impact from main production bases. It is predicted that the price will stay at low-priced fluctuations from late Apr. to May.

10. The import and export volume of China's PLA both saw decreases in Feb. 2014.
