In October 2013, China's new travel law was implemented to regulate fairer trade between travel agencies and tourists. The new law prohibits travel agencies from offering low-priced tours and then marking-up their profit margins by obtaining commissions from shops to which they bring their tour groups or requiring additional payment for services. The new law greatly affected arrivals to Taiwan, notably southern Taiwan in the fourth quarter of 2013. China, as the largest source market for...
