

Transport and Storage in Brazil

In 2020, the transport and storage industry in Brazil contracted, due to the adverse impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the Brazilian economy. The country's GDP declined by 4.7% in real terms, owing to lockdown measures, a drop in private consumption and deteriorating exports. Additionally, Brazil was still recovering from the 2015-16 economic crisis when the pandemic hit, complicating the already difficult path to economic stability.
