After a 6% decline in 2012 due to the bankruptcy of the national carrier Malév, transportation recovered in 2013 showing 3% value sales growth. After bankruptcy of Malév, air transportation was characterised by share takeover by low cost carriers, especially Wizzair and Ryanair. In 2013, this competition along with other low cost carriers turned into consolidation amongst the bigger players.
