Although the Belarusian government did not close the country's borders, the initial impact of the COVID-19 pandemic's subsequent lockdown across the world impacted tourism and travel in the country negatively. However, visitors to the country from a specified 37 countries were required to self-quarantine for 14 days between mid-April and mid-June. From 11 June 2020 all foreign citizens entering Belarus must provide a PCR-based COVID-19 test certificate acquired no longer than two days prior to e...
