

# Wealth Management Platform Market Opportunity, Growth Drivers, Industry Trend Analysis, and Forecast 2024 – 2032

The Global Wealth Management Platform Market was valued at USD 3.7 billion in 2023 and is projected to grow at a CAGR of 13% from 2024 to 2032. For example, in April 2024, Avenir, a wealth management fintech, secured \$500,000 in a pre-seed round. The funds will be used to develop software that evaluates businesses based on sustainability. Artificial intelligence (AI) is transforming wealth management platforms by streamlining advisory services and refining decision-making processes. Al-driven roboadvisors offer tailored investment suggestions, manage portfolios, and assess risks, all at a reduced cost. Leveraging predictive analytics, these platforms customize strategies to align with the financial aspirations and risk appetites of individual clients. This evolution is broadening the accessibility of wealth management, particularly for the younger, tech-oriented demographic, while allowing firms to scale their offerings. Furthermore, AI is boosting efficiency in compliance monitoring and fraud detection. The overall industry is divided into advisory mode, deployment model, application, end-use, and region. The market segments based on advisory mode include human advisory, robo advisory, and hybrid.

In 2023, human advisory claimed over 61% of the market share, attributed to its capacity for personalized, relationship-centric services that surpass digital platform offerings. High-net-worth individuals frequently gravitate towards the bespoke financial strategies provided by human advisors, adeptly addressing intricate needs like estate planning, tax optimization, and generational wealth transfer. Applications of wealth



management platforms span financial advice & management, portfolio, accounting, & trading management, performance management, risk & compliance management, and reporting. In 2023, the portfolio, accounting, & trading management segment held approximately 25% of the market share, underscoring its core role in the investment process and the demand for advanced, automated solutions. North America led the global wealth management platform market, capturing a substantial 36% share in 2023. Several factors contribute to the region's dominance, including a high concentration of wealth, a sophisticated financial infrastructure, and a robust embrace of digital technologies. The U.S., with its significant population of high-net-worth and ultra-high-net-worth individuals, naturally fuels the demand for advanced wealth management services. Moreover, the region's established financial services sector, bolstered by regulatory support for innovation, fosters an environment ripe for the evolution and adoption of cutting-edge wealth management platforms.



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
