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Abstracts

The South Korea orthopedic implants market size reached USD 1,109.0 Million in 2025. Looking forward, the market is expected to reach USD 1,564.2 Million by 2034, exhibiting a growth rate (CAGR) of 3.78% during 2026-2034. The market is expanding due to a growing aging population, rising incidence of orthopedic disorders, and advancements in surgical techniques and implant materials. Increasing demand for minimally invasive procedures and improved healthcare infrastructure also support growth. These factors collectively contribute to the rising South Korea orthopedic implants market share.
