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Abstracts

The Turkey IT training market size reached USD 722.6 Million in 2025. The market is projected to reach USD 937.1 Million by 2034, exhibiting a growth rate (CAGR) of 2.84% during 2026-2034. The market is driven by the increasing demand for skilled professionals in emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, cloud computing, and cybersecurity. Apart from this, the rapid digital transformation across various industries is further fueling the need for specialized IT training programs to enhance workforce capabilities and productivity. Additionally, government initiatives and investments in technology-driven education are facilitating access to high-quality training resources, further augmenting the Turkey IT training market share.

TURKEY IT TRAINING MARKET TRENDS:

Emergence of Online and Hybrid Learning Modes

As a response, specialized courses and training in cybersecurity, like training in ethical hacking, penetration testing, and risk management, have become an important part of IT training programs. Numerous Turkish institutions and training organizations currently provide customized courses that cater to the unique requirements of domestic industries, including banking, finance, and healthcare, where data protection is essential. With the changing threat landscape, continuous training programs will remain essential in the market.

Demand for Skills in Emerging Technologies

The growth of emerging technologies like artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning (ML), blockchain, and cloud computing is one of the key drivers fueling Turkey IT training market growth. These technologies are revolutionizing industries worldwide, and Turkey is not behind.
