The economy is stimulated by expanding global trade, especially with the European Union (EU), Middle East, and Asia, and export-led government initiatives as well as financial inclusion. Growing demand for working capital, supply chain finance, and digital banking services drives Turkey trade finance market share. As cross-border trade grows, businesses increasingly rely on secure, efficient, and cost-effective digital financing, making technology a central driver shaping the future of Turkey's trade finance ecosystem.
