The containerboard market, sustaining a 2.61% CAGR, is projected to expand to USD 166.006 billion in 2031 from USD 142.234 billion in 2025.

The containerboard market is defined by the production and supply of a specialized paperboard used as the primary raw material for manufacturing corrugated packaging. It consists of two core components: linerboard, which forms the smooth, strong outer facings, and corrugating medium, the fluted inner layer that provides cushioning, rigidity, and stacking strength. Combined, these materials create corrugated board, the world's most ubiquitous packaging substrate. The market's dynamics are intrinsically linked to global trade, consumer goods consumption, and logistical efficiency, serving as a fundamental enabler for the movement of products across all sectors.

Market expansion is overwhelmingly driven by the structural growth of e-commerce and evolving retail supply chains. The most powerful catalyst is the sustained, high-volume demand from the e-commerce packaging segment. The shift to online shopping necessitates robust, shippable, and often e-commerce-optimized (right-sized) corrugated boxes for last-mile delivery. This environmental advantage is driving brand owners and retailers to shift from plastic to fiber-based packaging, a trend known as 'paperization.' This is accelerating demand across retail, consumer goods, and food & beverage sectors, where companies are making public commitments to reduce virgin

plastic and increase recycled content.
