

Dental Appliance Market - Forecasts from 2020 to 2025

The dental appliance market is predicted to augment at a CAGR of 7.21% to reach US\$13,200.608 million in 2025 from US\$8,693.250 million in 2019. Dental appliances are referred to as common parts of dentistry and orthodontics that are denoted to any dental device involved in a dental treatment procedure. The appliances can be either permanent or removable. These help in repairing a damaged tooth or teeth or helps in the replacement of missing teeth, hence provide the best outcome from orthodontic care, contributing to improving the overall oral health. Furthermore, booming dental tourism is further providing an impetus in fueling the market growth during the forecast period.

On the basis of geography, North America and Europe are projected to hold a significant market share in the global dental appliances market owing to the advanced dental healthcare facilities in these regions. Furthermore, in the United States, there is a shift from volume-based care to the value-based care, contributing to surging the market growth during the course of the forecast period. COVID-19 impact on the dental appliances market: At present, amid novel coronavirus pandemic scenario, the dental industry worldwide is severely affected. This is because of the fact that the viral transmission takes place due to droplet infection, hence,

dentists are facing a tough time. Additionally, dental surgeons are currently at the highest level of risk of contracting and transmitting the deadly virus symptoms. This has resulted in temporary shut-down of dental clinics round the globe, further causing a decline in market growth as well. The reason being, dental appliances are being utilized by the dentists for dental treatment of patients and the closure of dental clinics has impacted the sales of dental appliances to these end-users in a negative manner during the novel coronavirus infection scenario.

Following the deduction of the price factor, the real increase was around 5%, and the per capita disposable income of rural households were reported to be around 16,021 yuan in 2019, achieving a growth of around 9.6% from 2018.

The most popular places for dentures and crowns include the United Kingdom, Mexico, Philippines, Costa Rica, and India.

It has been reported that most Americans are devoid of receiving dental insurance, hence for them a dental procedure may be quite expensive. As per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention analysis, more than a third of adults in America have not visited any dental professional in 2017. According to the American Dental Association, around 40% of American adults claimed that they did not visit the dentist due to the high cost. Hence, with soaring prices in the home country, patients find it quite convenient to travel to other regions for affordable dental care, further providing strong growth prospects for the market to thrive in the forecast period with a rise in dental tourism.
