Indonesia has experienced significant growth in its GDP over the last five years. It is expected to continue its growth momentum to reach US \$1.8 trillion at current prices by 2017 at a CAGR of 6.8% from 2012 to 2017. The average GDP growth rate from 2002 to 2011 was 5.3%, which made Indonesia one of the fastest-growing economies in Southeast Asia during that period.
