Summary

In an increasingly globalized and freely-trading world economy, the number of economically-important cities across the globe is growing rapidly. As developing regions continue to experience rapid and unsustainable economic growth the makeup of the global marketplace, and the relative importance of different regions, is changing constantly.

Key Highlights

Most major European cities have grown steadily since the crash in 2008-09, but there have been a number of smaller isolated recessions in some countries, for example Russia and Italy, and Europe as a region has yet to fully recover.

The vast majority of European cities are very similar; relatively small and mature with low GDP growth. There are a few outliers, for example Moscow which is currently experiencing rapid unsustainable growth but generally European cities are developed and healthy.

Nearly every European city is expected to experience a slowdown in population growth. Countries such as Italy, Germany and to a lesser extent Spain are struggling from an aging population which is likely to exert pressure on pension and healthcare services in the future.

Assesses their importance to the region in question in comparison to the rest of the major cities.

Provides an overview of various demographic indicators to assess the health of a city.

Provides a surface-level understanding of a particular region, its composition and what drives it.
