The North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) is a trade agreement between the countries in North America: the US, Canada and Mexico. The gas utilities industry within the NAFTA countries had a total market value of \$370.5 billion in 2017.The US was the fastest growing country, with a CAGR of 5.4% over the 2013-17 period.

Within the gas utilities industry, the US is the leading country among the NAFTA bloc, with market revenues of \$333.7 billion in 2017. This was followed by Canada and Mexico, with a value of \$28.2 and \$8.6 billion, respectively.

The US is expected to lead the gas utilities industry in the NAFTA bloc, with a value of \$481.8 billion in 2022, followed by Canada and Mexico with expected values of \$38.8 and \$11.7 billion, respectively.
