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SUMMARY

The Australian government spending sector had total revenues of \$472.7bn in 2020, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 11.6% between 2016 and 2020.

The social protection segment was the sector's most lucrative in 2020, with total revenues of \$135.1bn, equivalent to 28.6% of the sector's overall value.

The Australian government skyrocketed its expenditure in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, with the establishment of three support packages of

\$17bn, \$66bn and \$130bn respectively. However, this is expected to exacerbate the country's already high levels of national debt, which could have long-term implications for the sector.
