The North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) is a trade agreement between the countries in North America: the US, Canada and Mexico. The government spendings industry within the NAFTA countries had a total market value of \$9,740.7 billion in 2020. US was the fastest growing country, with a CAGR of 8.9% over the 2016-20 period.

Within the government spendings industry, the US is the leading country among the NAFTA bloc, with market revenues of \$9,138.2 billion in 2020. This was followed by Mexico and Canada, with a value of \$323.9 and \$278.6 billion, respectively.

US is expected to lead the government spendings industry in the NAFTA bloc, with a value of \$0.0 billion in 2025, followed by US and US with expected values

of \$0.0 and \$0.0 billion, respectively.
