SUMMARY

The world is entering a new period in history, a period of turbulence as the international order has become multipolar, with the leading superpower, the US, followed by its Western allies, increasing its antagonism with the challenging superpowers Russia and China, that pose as threats. Military alliances and spending are to play a crucial role in the new balance of powers and the race to the global hegemony.

The repercussions of the new Cold War and the alliance of Russia and China are set to be seen through the field of military spending of Western powers and their allies in three ways: the resurrection of NATO with its members states ramping up spending to increase their preparedness and deterrence; the expansion of the alliance of Westerns powers within or outside NATO; and the need of countries belonging to the Western influence to move away from Russian weaponry.
