SUMMARY

The South African waste management industry had total revenues of \$394.6m in 2019, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9.7% between 2015 and 2019.

Industry consumption volume increased with a CAGR of 2.8% between 2015 and 2019, to reach a total of 28 billion tons in 2019.

South Africa's population growth of 1.2% per year, an increase in environmental awareness, rapid industrialization, and a rise in urbanization will foster the growth of the waste management industry.
