

Grain Protectants Market by Control Method (Chemical (Insecticides, Fumigants, Rodenticides), Physical (Traps, Baits, Aeration, Heat Treatment), Biological), Target Pest (Insects, Rodents), Grain Type, and Region - Global Forecast to 2023

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Abstracts

“The grain protectants market is projected to grow at a CAGR of 4.86% during the forecast period.”

The grain protectants market is projected to reach USD 726.1 million by 2023, from USD 572.7 million in 2018, at a CAGR of 4.86%. The market is projected to grow at a steady rate, due to significant advancements in technologies for innovative products and the growing demand for grain protectants in the developing regions. The only factor hindering the growth of the grain protectants market is the development of insect pest resistance, which is a primary concern since certain pest populations have developed resistance to chemicals such as organophosphates, pyrethroids, carbamates, and certain other agents such as methoprene.

Commercialization of new active ingredients may take up to 10 years from the point of research and development phase; therefore, new innovations in the formulation is a necessity in the current chemistry to fulfill the technology gap constantly. In addition, companies have been expanding their R&D centers in other regions for introducing innovative capabilities to combat pest issues in grains. For instance, during July 2014, FMC Corporation strengthened its R&D capabilities by establishing a new Asia Innovation Center in Shanghai, China. The new facility is equipped with advanced

technologies to support technical innovation and R&D.

Corn is an important part of the staple food in countries such as Sub-Saharan Africa, Brazil, and Argentina. In these emerging markets, the post-harvest losses occurred for stored corn grains due to inadequate drying and improper storage facilities, which lead to infestation by insects and rodents.

In 2016, nearly 60% of the corn cultivated across the globe was used as feed. Due to the increasing protein demand from the emerging markets, the demand for corn is expected to grow in the coming years. Therefore, corn holds a larger share among other grain types such as wheat, rice, and sorghum.

“North America is projected to be the fastest-growing market for grain protectants through 2023.”

The market for grain protectants in the North American region is projected to grow at the highest CAGR from 2018 to 2023. The high adoption of grain protection practices by large-scale farmers in the region and the presence of major manufacturers are the factors responsible for this growth. Even though corn is the most widely grown crop in China and the US—which together produced about 56% of the world’s harvest in 2017, as per the USDA—the adoption of grain protectants for corn in the US is higher than that in China.

The breakdown of the primaries on the basis of company type, designation, and region conducted during the research study is as follows:

By Company type: Tier 1 – 50%, Tier 2 – 34%, and Tier 3 – 16%

By Designation: C-level – 15%, D-level – 35%, and Others – 50%

By Region: Asia Pacific – 40%, Europe – 20%, Americas – 15%, and RoW - 25%
