#### **Abstracts**

It is widely recognised that a handful of Asian countries (notably Japan, Korea and Singapore) rank at the top of the table for rolling out super-fast broadband networks, creating and implementing necessary regulatory measures in the process. With the governments of both Australia and New Zealand recently announcing national broadband strategies, the Asia-Pacific region continues to attract international attention. This report provides a current snapshot of the regulatory treatment of fibre in select Asia-Pacific countries.
