Abstracts

The site management organization market is expected to reach USD 8.5 million by 2021 anticipated to grow at a CAGR of 10% during the forecast period 2021-2035

Clinical trials constitute a pivotal element in drug development, crucial for evaluating a candidate's safety and efficacy. Statistics suggest that about 40% of the investment in drug development, amounting to roughly USD 78 billion annually, is directed towards these trials. However, conducting these trials poses several challenges, spanning scientific and operational complexities, difficulties in recruitment and retention, concerns regarding data management, and stricter regulatory requirements. The involvement of various stakeholders in this multifaceted process often results in delays, with over 80% of trials being postponed by one to six months, and only 10% completing on schedule. Consequently, the pharmaceutical industry continuously seeks ways to improve the clinical trial process and its management. Among several strategies, outsourcing trial



operations to specialized service providers, such as site management organizations (SMOs), has emerged as a viable option. Involving these providers offers numerous advantages, enabling sponsors to adhere to research timelines. SMOs can expedite patient recruitment, shorten study durations, and oversee the entire trial process and administrative tasks for their clients. Moreover, pharmaceutical innovators, contract research organizations (CROs), and even developers of medical devices can utilize SMOs' therapeutic and operational expertise, global site networks, and established processes to conduct clinical research and manage sites efficiently in terms of both time and cost. Presently, approximately 250 companies claim to actively provide SMO services to drug and medical device developers worldwide. Recent developments in the site management market focus on consolidating capabilities, expanding service portfolios, and collaborating to broaden geographical coverage. These trends arise from sponsor companies' preference for comprehensive service providers and the increasing recognition of outsourcing as a beneficial model for clinical trial management and research site administration. With the growing complexity and registration of more clinical trials, the demand for SMOs is expected to experience steady market growth in the forecast period.
