This software deployment enables accounting teams to dynamically generate complex customer invoices, audit multi-currency payment streams, and configure end-of-term subscription quotes using plain-language conversational prompts without manually accessing the core billing interface.

In March 2026, Xero Limited launched an optimized suite of automated cash flow and invoicing modules within its cloud accounting platform, anchored by the introduction of its 'JAX' smart assistant workflows. This digital platform upgrade enables small and medium enterprises to process multi-client billing runs through conversational task handling, automate the matching of line-item invoice data against incoming bank feeds.
