Region with largest share:

Region with highest CAGR:

Expanding youth populations and growing disposable incomes support premium education adoption. Government initiatives promoting digital literacy and community empowerment further accelerate growth. Key Developments:

More significantly, Udemy has ongoing content provider agreements with institutions like The Muse and Thrive Global, integrating their career and personal development content directly into the Udemy Business platform to bolster its life skills and professional development catalog for corporate clients.

In February 2024, Coursera deepened its partnership with the UK government to offer 15,000 fully funded seats for professional certificates from Google, IBM, and Meta. This initiative, a key part of the UK's 'Skills for Life' program, directly targets workforce

development by providing citizens with in-demand digital and career-oriented life skills, expanding access to its industry-focused curriculum.
