According to NIH funded analysis published in JAMA, the percentage of U.S. adults using at least one complementary health approach (such as yoga, meditation, massage therapy, chiropractic care, acupuncture, naturopathy, or guided imagery) increased from 19.2 % in 2002 to 36.7 % in 2022

Threat:

Competition from conventional medicine innovations

These systems, such as Ayurveda, Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM), and Homeopathy, provide a complete framework for understanding and treating health conditions, often addressing the root cause rather than just symptoms. Their long-standing historical presence and cultural acceptance in many parts of the world also contribute to their widespread adoption and significant market share.

The direct sales/practitioner sales segment is expected to have the highest CAGR during the forecast period

Region with largest share:

The region benefits from a growing trend of individuals proactively seeking preventative care and holistic solutions for chronic conditions dominating position in the market.

Region with highest CAGR:

Over the forecast period, the Asia Pacific region is anticipated to exhibit the highest CAGR driven by the rich traditional medicine heritage in countries like China and India, where CAM practices are deeply embedded in the culture and widely accepted. The rising disposable incomes, increasing prevalence of chronic diseases, and growing awareness about the benefits are also significant contributing factors. Furthermore, supportive government initiatives promoting traditional medicine and the expanding accessibility of CAM services are propelling the rapid expansion of the Complementary and Alternative Medicine market across the Asia Pacific region.
