Region with largest share:

In March 2026, Tate & Lyle PLC extended its strategic partnership with Van Triest CirQlar to manage the sales and distribution of citrus pulp co-products from its Gro?enbrode facility. This collaborative initiative leverages specialized market expertise to turn pectin production residuals into circular value chains, allowing Tate & Lyle to focus on its core portfolio of functional sweetening and fortification ingredients.

In December 2025, Sudzucker AG reported that its "Special Products" segment, which includes functional carbohydrates like Palatinose™ and Beneo fiber, is expected to drive significant earnings improvements through the 2026/27 financial year. This product-led growth strategy is supported by increasing sales volumes in the nutraceutical space, offsetting the "highly challenging" conditions currently facing the traditional European sugar market.
