Key Developments:

In May 2026, Epic Systems Corporation released a dedicated "Neurodiversity Navigator" care module within its comprehensive Cosmos clinical database network.

In March 2026, Philips Healthcare entered a joint venture to build an enterprise-level, predictive cognitive wellness platform for institutional healthcare workers. The program tracks long-term neurological stress metrics to identify acute physician burnout indicators before clinical symptoms manifest.

In November 2025, Veradigm LLC finalized an interoperability partnership to embed custom applied behavior analysis reporting functions into its central clinical network. This integration allows independent neurodiversity providers to instantly sync documentation data with primary care networks.
