Threat:

Supply Chain Issues

Supply chain disruptions represent a critical threat to the market. Dependence on raw materials from multiple regions, coupled with logistical challenges and transportation delays, can affect product availability and increase costs. Unexpected disruptions, such

as geopolitical tensions or natural disasters, may impact ingredient sourcing and manufacturing timelines. Such instability can hinder timely delivery to retailers and consumers, affecting brand reputation and revenue. Efficient supply chain management and contingency planning are essential to mitigate these risks and maintain market stability.

Covid-19 Impact:

The Covid-19 pandemic influenced the pet wellness supplements market in multiple ways. While lockdowns temporarily disrupted production and distribution channels, they also increased pet adoption rates as people spent more time at home. Heightened awareness of health and immunity for pets led to a surge in demand for supplements targeting immune support, digestive health, and overall wellness. The small mammals segment is expected to be the largest during the forecast period

The small mammals segment is expected to account for the largest market share during the forecast period due to rising popularity of pets such as rabbits, guinea pigs, and hamsters has driven demand for specialized wellness supplements. These animals require targeted nutrition, including vitamins, minerals, and probiotics, to maintain digestive health, immunity, and vitality. Increased awareness among pet owners about species-specific health requirements, coupled with rising pet adoption rates, supports the growth of this segment. Manufacturers are focusing on tailored formulations to meet these unique nutritional needs.

The digestive health segment is expected to have the highest CAGR during the forecast period

Over the forecast period, the digestive health segment is predicted to witness the highest growth rate, due to growing concerns about gastrointestinal issues in pets, such as bloating, diarrhea, and nutrient absorption challenges, have fueled demand for probiotics, prebiotics, and digestive enzyme supplements. Pet owners increasingly prioritize preventive care to enhance overall health and longevity. Innovation in formulation, such as natural and palatable supplements, is driving adoption. This focus on digestive wellness aligns with the broader trend of functional and preventive pet nutrition, positioning the segment for rapid growth.

Region with largest share:

During the forecast period, the Asia Pacific region is expected to hold the largest market share, due to rising disposable income, and increased pet ownership are driving demand for pet wellness supplements. Cultural shifts toward pet humanization and greater awareness of preventive health measures further supports market expansion. Key markets such as China, India, and Japan are witnessing strong growth due to a combination of rising pet adoption, evolving consumer lifestyles, and expanding retail channels, including e-commerce, making Asia Pacific a dominant contributor to global market revenue.

Region with highest CAGR:

Over the forecast period, the North America region is anticipated to exhibit the highest CAGR, owing to High pet ownership, coupled with a strong focus on preventive healthcare and premium nutrition, is fueling rapid adoption. Advanced retail infrastructure, widespread awareness of functional supplements, and innovative product offerings, including targeted formulations for immunity, joint, and digestive health, contribute to growth. Additionally, the region's mature regulatory framework ensures product safety and quality, fostering consumer trust and accelerating market penetration, making North America a key growth hotspot.

Key Developments:

In June 2025, Zoetis has signed a strategic consulting deal with global IT firm Infosys to boost its digital capabilities and IT operations. Under the long-term engagement, Infosys will integrate advanced AI and automation solutions to enhance agility, improve operational efficiency, and better support veterinarians, livestock producers, and pet owners worldwide.

In December 2025, Zoetis and Colorado State University's AgNext have launched a

strategic cattle research collaboration to deepen scientific understanding of sustainable livestock production. The partnership will gather baseline data on greenhouse gas emissions and conduct lifecycle assessments to inform better animal health, in response to evolving sustainability goals.
