The fully online segment is expected to have the highest CAGR during the forecast period

Over the forecast period, the fully online segment is predicted to witness the highest growth rate, propelled by global accessibility, convenience, and cost-effectiveness. Learners can participate from any location without relocating or adjusting work

schedules. Institutions leverage advanced learning management systems, interactive platforms, and AI-driven personalization to enhance engagement. The fully online model supports continuous upskilling and side projects, making it highly compatible with the gig economy and lifelong learning trends. Region with largest share:
