Region with highest CAGR:

Over the forecast period, the Asia Pacific region is anticipated to exhibit the highest CAGR, fueled by rapid expansion of education systems, increasing focus on student employability, and growing adoption of digital career services across major economies. Countries such as China, India, and Australia are witnessing significant investment in education technology and workforce development. The large student population and emphasis on career preparation create demand for career management solutions. Government initiatives promoting skill development and digital education further contribute to regional market growth.
