Europe Edible Oils Market was valued at USD 19.47 billion in 2024 and is anticipated to grow to USD 27.01 billion by 2030 with a CAGR of 5.67% during forecast period. The EU also produces 5 million tonnes of protein crops used in food and feed applications.
