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Abstracts

Middle East Cleaning Services Market is anticipated to register a high CAGR during the forecast period 2024-2028.

There are several people employed in the cleaning sector. Booming Tourism and Hospitality Sector

Saudi Arabia

Owing to enormous investments made in infrastructure expansion, the tourist and hospitality sectors in the Middle East have been growing. By making these expenditures with the twin objectives of luring visitors and improving the economy, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) is getting ready for INDEX Saudi Arabia, a trade fair for interior design, furniture, among other things, which took place in September 2022. The government has allotted USD 810 million for initiatives in the arts, recreation, and entertainment in order to increase tourism and improve the nation's tourist and hospitality infrastructure. By 2030, the Travel & Tourism industry is predicted to contribute more than 10% of the GDP, according to the Ministry of Tourism, Saudi Tourism Authority, and Tourism Development Fund.

UAE

The government has invested a lot of money in building infrastructure, which has helped Dubai's tourist and hospitality sectors grow. Such investments have been made in

anticipation of foreign investments in the country while simultaneously attracting visitors and preparing the country for the international event Dubai Expo 2020, which ended in March 2022. Plans such as the 'Dubai Tourism Strategy 2025' and the 'Dubai 2040 Urban Master Plan,' which aims to increase visitor numbers in Dubai and grow tourism and hospitality infrastructure in the nation by 134%, which are improving the UAE tourism and hospitality sector. The Global Travel and Tourism Council predicts that in 2027, the travel and tourism sector in the UAE would generate revenues of roughly 72 billion USD and contribute 12.7% to GDP. As a result, it is expected that in the years to come, a growing tourism and hospitality sector would drive the UAE Cleaning Services market. Sharjah is also being significantly impacted by the growth of industrial zones, new tourism projects, retail infrastructure, and the local residential sector. The Moon Retreat in Mleiha, Al Suhub Rest House in Khorfakkan, Kalba Waterfront, and other key tourism-related projects have all been announced by the Sharjah Commerce and Tourism Development Authority (SCTDA). These factors are anticipated to raise the demand for cleaning services in Sharjah during the forecast period.

Qatar

Recently, the FIFA World Cup 2022 concluded in Qatar and was one of the main reasons affecting the country's cleaning services. The construction of sports arenas, practice fields, and other infrastructure led to an increase in facility management across the nation, including cleaning services and landscaping. In order to host the event, more than 10% of the yearly national production was typically invested in infrastructure development. For example, the nation constructed a 40,000-seat modular arena for the same, complete with seats, snack stands, restrooms, stores, and other amenities. Qatar has invested approximately USD 220 billion in the development of the nation's infrastructure. Thus, it is anticipated that demand for cleaning services is expected to increase in the upcoming years.

Growing Smart Cities Concept

Saudi Arabia

Saudi Arabia intends to create a number of smart, sustainable cities around the country in line with the "Saudi Vision 2030" and city-level programs such as the Red Sea Development Project and the King Abdullah Economic City, which support the development of sustainable infrastructure. According to Saudi Arabia, "smart cities" are urban development initiatives that prioritise the environment and are technologically integrated with the most recent ICT (Information & Communication Technologies) and

the Internet of Things (IoT). With major initiatives such as Al-Qiddiya, Entertainment City, the Neom, Al Faisaliah City, King Abdullah Financial District, Dahiyat Al Fursan, and the transformation of Makkah, Riyadh, Jeddah, Al-Madinah, and Al-Ahsa into smart cities, Saudi Arabia has made significant strides in developing smart cities. As a result, green building standards are being followed in the construction of the nation's planned smart, sustainable communities. Such high goals ought to offer a tonne of potential for Saudi Arabia's authorised cleaning services companies.

UAE

In direct agreement with city-level initiatives such as the "Dubai 2040 Urban Master Plan" and the "Abu Dhabi Economic Vision 2030," which encourage the creation of sustainable infrastructure, the UAE wants to build a number of smart sustainable cities around the country. It is projected that the cleaning services sector in the UAE are expected to considerably profit from such initiatives.

Qatar

Qatar is making significant investments in the infrastructure of smart cities and cutting-edge technologies including cleantech, IoT, smart mobility, and artificial intelligence. According to specialists, speaking at an online event, the Qatar Free Zones Authority (QFZA) is concentrating its economic development efforts on luring, partnering with, and investing in international firms to create technological clusters that would aid in achieving the nation's objectives. Msheireb Downtown, a USD 5.5 billion mixed-use area encompassing 31,000 square metres, and Lusail City, a USD 45 billion smart metropolis covering 38 square kilometres, are two significant smart cities of the future now being created in Qatar. By 2030, the project is expected to be operational, thereby, driving the Middle East Cleaning Services market during the forecast period, 2024-2028.
