The market's expansion is fueled by the growing elderly population and a rise in chronic diseases such as cancer, anemia, and cardiovascular disorders, all of which contribute to higher blood transfusion requirements. Blood bags, which are designed for safe collection, storage, and transportation of blood, play a vital role in maintaining an efficient and reliable blood supply system across Spain's healthcare facilities.

Technological advancements in blood bag materials and design are a significant trend, enhancing blood preservation and minimizing contamination risks. Innovations such as high-quality, durable materials, and improved seals ensure that blood bags are safer and more efficient, prolonging the shelf life of blood products. The demand for more eco-friendly and recyclable blood bag options is also gaining traction as hospitals and healthcare systems increasingly focus on sustainability.

The increasing prevalence of chronic diseases like cardiovascular conditions, diabetes, and cancer also reinforces the growing demand for blood transfusions. These

conditions often require frequent transfusions or the use of specific blood components as part of ongoing treatments, thus sustaining the demand for blood bags in healthcare facilities.

Spain's healthcare system, alongside various non-governmental organizations, has made significant efforts to promote voluntary blood donations. Awareness campaigns and blood donation drives across the country have successfully encouraged more individuals to donate, ensuring a steady supply of blood. For example, the Spanish Red Cross conducted over 5,000 blood donation campaigns in 2023 alone, significantly contributing to the available blood supply.

However, the short shelf life of blood remains a key limitation, making it critical to maintain a continuous, reliable flow of donations to meet ongoing healthcare needs.
