United States Diapers Market was valued at USD 22.62 Billion in 2024 and is expected to reach USD 26.70 Billion by 2030 with a CAGR of 2.8% during the forecast period. The United States diaper market is experiencing steady growth, driven by rising awareness of hygiene, technological advancements, and increasing demand for convenience. The market is segmented into disposable and cloth diapers by product type, baby and adult by end user, and multiple sales channels, including supermarkets/hypermarkets, pharmacies/drug stores, departmental stores, convenience stores, online platforms, and non-retail avenues.
