Chemicals are an industry that plays an important role in economic development, providing inputs for many essential industries for production and consumption such as fertilizers, paints and inks, and pesticides. materials, detergents ... The chemical industry has 8 product groups, in Q4 / 2019, the export value of the chemical industry accounts for about xx% of the country's total export turnover.

Fertilizers and nitrogen compounds: Fertilizer consumption in Q4 / 2019 decreased by xx% compared to the same period in 2018. Imports of fertilizers increased by xx% in volume over the same period in 2018 due to production in low countries, policies to cut production, ..
