Vitrolife also expanded access to time-lapse imaging through commercialization of the EmbryoScope 8 platform, which accommodates multiple patients simultaneously within a compact incubator design. The system incorporates an isolated loading chamber that minimizes temperature and gas fluctuations during operation while reducing gas consumption and simplifying quality control procedures. These developments reflect broader industry priorities centered on automation, embryo traceability, workflow efficiency, and

enhanced imaging capabilities that support consistent reproductive laboratory performance.

France's market is also being pulled by demographics. INSEE estimates that on 1 January 2026 France had 69.1 million inhabitants, with 22% aged 65 or over. INSEE also reported that 2025 births were 645,000 and deaths were 651,000, producing a negative natural balance of about 6,000 for the first time since the end of the Second World War.

The price sensitive market access is broad through the public system, private coverage adds a sizeable premium layer, and reimbursement, procurement, and hospital efficiency remain key buying drivers.
