The revised dosing schedule preserves the therapeutic efficacy demonstrated with earlier bi-weekly subcutaneous administration protocols while reducing treatment frequency and clinical administration demands. Such developments reflect increasing industry emphasis on patient convenience, healthcare workflow optimization, and long-term treatment adherence within targeted lung cancer management.

Strategic Oncology Partnerships Accelerate Pipeline Expansion

Large-scale collaborations are becoming a major mechanism for expanding lung cancer therapeutic pipelines. Bristol Myers Squibb entered a broad strategic partnership with Jiangsu Hengrui Pharmaceuticals valued at up to \$15.2 billion, encompassing 13 development programs across oncology, hematology, and immunology.
