dermatological conditions. Such developments reflect broader industry efforts to optimize therapeutic convenience alongside clinical efficacy. As competition among advanced dermatology therapies intensifies, manufacturers are increasingly focusing on treatment durability, simplified administration schedules, and improved patient quality of life as key differentiating factors.

Rare Disease Research and Novel Immune Targets Are Expanding Therapeutic Opportunities
