ANS reported 53.2 million medical-plan beneficiaries in December 2025, while IBGE projects a steady rise in older-age cohorts, with people aged 60+ already representing about 23% of the population. The price sensitive market access is broad through the public system, private coverage adds a sizeable premium layer, and reimbursement, procurement, and hospital efficiency remain key buying drivers.
