Increasing prevalence of chronic liver diseases, viral hepatitis, metabolic disorders, and drug-induced liver injury is driving routine measurement of alanine aminotransferase (ALT) and aspartate aminotransferase (AST) across hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, pharmaceutical companies, and research institutions. The market is also benefiting from advances in automated clinical chemistry platforms, standardized assay methodologies, and high-throughput laboratory workflows that support rapid and accurate biochemical analysis.

Similarly, GlaxoSmithKline incorporated specialized kinetic transaminase assays into its pivotal Phase 3 B-Well 1 and B-Well 2 clinical trials evaluating bepirovirsen for chronic Hepatitis B, requiring ALT levels to remain within defined clinical thresholds alongside viral surface antigen clearance when assessing functional cure outcomes. These developments demonstrate the growing integration of transaminase testing into regulatory compliance, precision therapeutics, and evidence-based clinical decision-making.

Advanced Laboratory Assays are Improving Diagnostic Efficiency and Research Capabilities.

Manufacturers are introducing optimized assay technologies that simplify laboratory workflows while improving analytical performance. RayBiotech expanded the market with its Alanine Transaminase Activity Assay Kit for serum, plasma, and other multi-species biological fluids, utilizing an enzymatic coupled-reaction methodology that measures NADH oxidation through kinetic absorbance at 340 nm. The assay enables laboratories to generate quantitative ALT activity profiles within approximately 30 minutes without requiring standard calibration curves, supporting faster biochemical analysis in both research and diagnostic environments. Continued innovation in assay chemistry, automation, and analytical sensitivity is strengthening the industry's ability to deliver reliable liver function testing across clinical diagnostics, pharmaceutical development, and biomedical research.

INSEE also reported that 2025 births were 645,000 and deaths were 651,000, producing a negative natural balance of about 6,000 for the first time since the end of the Second World War.

UK Transaminase Test Market Size, Share, and Growth Projections to 2034- Rapid growth driven by new and existing brands across the industry value chain

Small high-need consumer segments remain key priority of Transaminase Test distributors in the UK industry. The price sensitive market access is broad through the public system, private coverage adds a sizeable premium layer, and reimbursement, procurement, and hospital efficiency remain key buying drivers.
